- PSRC is not responsible for lost, late, inaccurate, incomplete, or misdirected entries.

How to Enter

- Photograph must be in a digital format.
- File **must be** 5 megabytes or smaller, in **jpeg or tif** format, and **300 dpi** or higher. **File should be named with your full name and school.**
- Email your submission to snapandshare@robeson.k12.nc.us
Include your name, address, phone number, email address and a **one sentence** description of your photograph.
- A panel of judges will select one photograph each month that is the best representation of the theme and has exceptional quality.
