**RE:** High School Beta Club Guidelines (Grades 9-12)

- **Induction:** Students will be inducted in the spring of each year. Grades from the first 2 nine-week periods will be used to compute the scholastic requirements for membership. The scholastic requirements shall be a 3.3 weighted average in high school with no grade lower than an 80 and no unsatisfactory in any courses (grade requirement applies throughout 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades) and no suspensions (ISS included) during the year of membership. Students must perform on or above grade level in order to be recommended for membership. Members may not have any suspensions (ISS included) that year.
- **Loss of Membership:** A member of the Senior Beta Club in the Public Schools of Robeson County will be dropped from membership if he/she is absent without an excused reason from 2 (two) regular meetings. The principal will approve/excuse absences.  
A member of The Senior Beta Club will be dropped from membership if his/her scholastic record falls below an 80 or 3.0 weighted average in high school when computed for all courses. However, no member may be dropped from membership for scholastic deficiency without being accorded a probationary period of 2 nine-week grading periods to raise his/her scholastic record to at least an 80 by the end of that second nine-week period.  
A member of the Senior Beta Club will be dropped from membership if suspended (ISS included). Membership cannot be reinstated within grades 9th-12th.

- **Attendance:** Members must attend all Beta Club meetings and functions. Two excused absences will be allowed per academic year. The principal will approve/excuse absences.
- **Scholastic and Conduct Requirements for Membership:** Members are required to have a 3.3 weighted average in high school with no grade lower than an 80 and no unsatisfactory in any courses (grade requirement applies throughout 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade) and no suspensions (ISS included) during the year of membership.
- **Scholastic and Conduct Requirements for Induction:** Potential members may not have been suspended (ISS included) or received a grade lower than an 80 or unsatisfactory in any course within their time in high school starting in 9th grade.
- **Scholastic and Conduct Requirements for continued membership:** Members must maintain a grade of 80 or above in each course and no suspensions (ISS included).
- **Probation:** Members will be placed on probation if grades fall below an 80 within any nine-week period. If placed on probation, grades will be reviewed for 2 nine-week grading periods and the member will either be taken off probation (if grades have improved to at least an 80 by the end of that second nine-week period) or dismissed from Beta Club (if grades are below an 80 by the second nine-week period)
