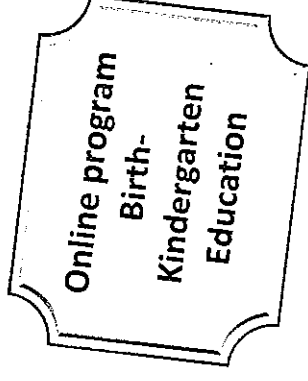

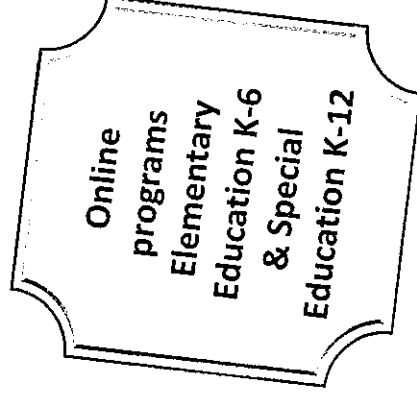

Beginning September 1, 2019, all candidates seeking initial licensure in North Carolina will be required to submit qualifying scores on the appropriate edTPA performance-based, subject-specific assessment. Please check with your faculty advisor about program-specific edTPA requirements established for 2019.

# Residency Licensure @ the University of North Carolina at Pembroke

UNCP's Residency Licensure Program will meet the needs of residency candidates seeking initial licensure in North Carolina. Residency at UNCP is designed to support residency candidates in their first years of teaching through coursework, university partnerships and assisting candidates in meeting licensure requirements.

The Residency License as defined in (§ 115C.270.20.a.5) as:

A one-year license, renewable twice, that meets both of the following requirements:

- a. Is requested by the local board of education and accompanied by a certification of supervision from the recognized educator preparation program in which the individual is enrolled.
- b. The individual for whom the license is requested meets all of the following requirements:
  1. Holds a bachelor's degree.
  2. Has either completed coursework relevant to the requested licensure area or passed the content area examination relevant to the requested licensure area that has been approved by the State Board.
  3. Is enrolled in a recognized educator preparation program.
  4. Meets all other requirements established by the State Board, including completing preservice requirements prior to teaching.

Candidates are hired by an LEA and have earned a bachelor's degree and must have 24 semester hours in the licensure area or have passed all NCSBE required assessments. All residency candidates will begin the process with their LEA. Complete the LEA-EPP Verification form and then apply to UNCP – uploading transcripts and the form.

- Residency programs at the graduate level will complete a Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) with 30 credit hours. Apply at [gradapply.uncp.edu](http://gradapply.uncp.edu)
- Residency programs for licensure only in Art, Birth-Kindergarten, Music, Science and Spanish will apply at [bridge2brave.uncp.edu](http://bridge2brave.uncp.edu)
- All residency candidates will complete licensure requirements during their program including edTPA during an internship completed in their classroom
- Candidates with a cumulative GPA below 2.7 may be enrolled provisionally and complete the 12-hour Residency Education Core with a 3.0 overall GPA to be recommended for full admission to UNCP's residency licensure programs.
